ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR THE MAR- SALINE BRANCH SCHOLARSHIP

(HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS ONLY)

1. Applicants must be graduating high school seniors.
2. Applicants must possess a grade average of at least 2.5 out of 4.0 system (C+)
3. All recipients must be full-time students.
4. All recipients must be either citizens of the United States or be enrolled in an accredited college in the United States.
5. Applicants may apply for more than one NAACP scholarship, but cannot receive more than one.
6. The Mar-Saline Scholarships are not renewable.

THE APPLICATION PROCESS WILL REQUIRE THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS

- A. Application form – all applications **MUST BE TYPED.**
XEROX COPIES will not be accepted.
- B. Two letters of recommendation: (other than relatives) one personal reference, one academic reference
- C. Current official transcript of grades (high school).
- D. Financial information:
Copy of Parents Income Tax Forms and W-2 Forms
- E. Copy of application for admission or letter of acceptance from college or university.
- F. Wallet size photograph. The name should be written on the back of the photograph.
- G. All information must be forwarded in one package. No separate pieces other than transcript and financial aid forms will be accepted.
